CUSTOMER INFORMATION ON ROHS AND POP

CUSTOMER INFORMATION ON REACH

Faber-Castell is applying and importing chemical raw material for manufacturing of high quality writing and drawing instruments. Since June 2007 the new EU regulation on chemicals REACH* is supervising the use and marketing of chemical substances within the EU. Henceforth all substances have to be registered by the European Chemicals Agency ECHA with regard to the specific use of the substance.

Faber-Castell as user of chemical material strongly sticks to this responsibility. In January 2008 a REACH project team has been founded, which, in coordination with our suppliers, focuses on the identification and assessment of all chemical substances used. In addition, Faber-Castell also organizes the registration if required.

Registration of Substances

On June 1st, 2008 the pre-registration phase started and from January 1st, 2009 onwards the main registration process commenced, which expired on 31.05.2018 with the last registration deadline. These deadlines were strictly observed by Faber-Castell. We thus ensure the further smooth marketing of our products.

After completion of the registration phase of substances on 31.05.2018 we confirm: All products



distributed in Europe by Faber-Castell are only containing substances which, as far as required, have been registered.

Information on Substances in Articles

The new European directive on chemicals REACH regulates in title IV the information flow in the supply chain. Faber-Castell is part of this supply chain and certainly will meet the information requirements towards our downstream users and clients. Article 33 notifies that substances included in annex XIV, according to article 57 SVHC** substances, may only amount to a maximum of 0.1 mass percentage in products or parts of them. In case the concentration of SVHC substances exceeds this limit the downstream user / client has to be informed. The list of substances in annex XIV is open and certainly will be extended in the next few years. In preparation of the inclusion of these substances in annex XIV by the ECHA, for the time being the candidate list comprises a limited number of substances and substance groups.

We hereby declare that we as downstream user / formulator require of all suppliers to certify that in accordance with the current candidate list no SVHC substances exceeding 0.1 mass percentage in substances and products and parts thereof are contained. Random checks of the SVHC substances relevant for the corresponding component will be made.

Restriction of Substances

Annex XVII of REACH restricts on the manufacture, placing on the market and use of certain dangerous substances, preparations and articles. All products produced and placed on the market by Faber-Castell meet these requirements.
